MINT CHIP was unhurried into stride, angled in to save ground, advanced along the inside through the second turn, worked her way to the outside nearing the quarter pole, came five wide into the stretch, swiftly reeled in the leaders inside the furlong marker and quickly kicked away. BRAVE PROSPECT tracked the pace two wide, continued on well through a prolonged drive but was unable to match strides with the winner through the final furlong. GOLD MEDALLION opened clear and set all the pace in hand, but weakened in the final furlong and gave way. SLAMMY BOY broke a bit slow, was hustled along between horses in mid pack, moved with the winner through the second turn, was carried out into the stretch, but kept on fairly well to improve his position. BK'S OTHER BROTHER was forwardly placed along the inside, got through entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. LETSGETITONMON settled in hand three deep, offered a mild bid between rivals with five-sixteenths to run but failed to sustain the effort. POINTMAN TALKIN saved ground to no avail. SILLIUM made a middle move three wide to close the gap but came up empty after six furlongs and dropped out.
