COLONIAL FLAG close up while off the inside, challenged once in the stretch, inherited a longer lead when MAID ON A MISSION swerved over the inside rail then lasted late. CENTRE COURT close up along the inside, angled out a bit for the drive and was gaining late. PRAISE BAND forwardly placed off the inside, moved out four wide approaching the stretch when rallying but lacked a late bid. PRISSY broke slowly, was outrun for a half, commenced her rally off the inside on the second turn, angled out for the drive and made a solid late gain. CANNALITA outrun for a half, saved ground on the second turn and was no real threat. ROYAL FURY forwardly placed three wide, held on well to the final furlong and tired. JUST SAY HEY took up entering the first turn when JOLIE JOKER drifted out, was outrun thereafter and never menaced. HAPPY NOW carried wide into the first turn, angled in on the backstretch, made an inside move into the second turn but gave way in the drive. KISS AN ANGEL reserved early, moved out to the three path on the second turn when within reach but had nothing left late. JOLIE JOKER steadied when drifting wide on the first turn, was out in the five path entering the backstretch, stayed on well to the final quarter and faded. G G GAL steadied into the first turn when eager and in traffic, dropped back on the backstretch, swerved out in midstretch and was no late factor. MAID ON A MISSION sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace, swerved in in midstretch and flipped over the inside rail. THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND FOLLOWING A STEWARDS INQUIRY.
