VIVID SUNSET, under snug restraint from early on, was eased in behind the dueling leaders nearing the first turn, was full of run on the backstretch while pulling the rider up to contest the pace from between foes, wrested command nearing the stretch and drew away when ridden out. WELCOME SURPRISE, outrun for six furlongs, made a mild bid four wide to earn her position while no threat to VIVID SUNSET. FAST DELIVERY saved ground in a striking position throughout but lacked a closing bid. MOUNTAIN ANGEL bobbled at the start, quickly recovered to maneuver inside, gained a slight edge on the backstretch while dueling, showed the way until nearing the stretch and faded. ICE CREAM DREAM, bumped soundly at the start and forced out on DOUBLE DEVILS FOOD, was outrun until nearing the stretch, made a mild bid to reach contention but lacked a further account. DOUBLE DEVILS FOOD, bumped at the start, passed tired ones. WATCH broke alertly but drifted out soon after bumping ICE CREAM DREAM, gained a slight edge, lost the advantage to MOUNTAIN ANGEL while dueling with that one and tired upon going six furlongs. TRA was finished early on the second turn. WILD WON was outrun.
