Footnotes

LIMEHOUSE, never far back while tracking the dueling leaders four wide, continued in that manner into the stretch and, despite drifting in and out a bit under left-handed whipping, closed determinedly to be along in time. CHERNIAVSKY, close up inside early, rallied from the rail to gain the lead leaving the turn but couldn't hold the winner safe. COLD TRICK gained a narrow advantage at the start, made the pace until the final quarter and weakened gradually. SEA DOCTOR, four or five wide throughout, failed to rally. SERVICE CHARGE, outrun to the stretch, never reached contention while improving position. DRIFTER, within striking distance to the stretch while in behind the leaders, continued near the inside but flattened out. BOLD AND ROYAL, slow to start and squeezed back, was outrun. PLATINUM PRINCE also broke slowly and never menaced while five or six wide.
