REASON TO TALK gained the lead inside early, went along under careful handling, relaxed nicely while controlling the pace through even fractions, put away SALTY FARMA approaching the stretch, then widened in the drive under mild hand urging. SALTY FARMA, in closest attendance to REASON TO TALK from the early on, stalked that one three or four wide, offered an earnest challenge on the far turn, couldn't keep pace soon after going six furlongs and was fully extended to save the place. EXTEND broke in the air, was checked in behind the leaders approaching the first turn, was put to a drive four wide on the second turn, then couldn't offer a late response. SEVEN FOUR SEVEN, four or five wide most of the trip, faded upon going six furlongs.
