MYSTERY GUEST within striking distance off the rail, responded when asked for his best in the stretch and closed willingly to be up late between rivals. TRIUMPHAL reserved early, moved out five wide late on the turn and rallied willingly on the outside to be slowly gaining late. STONEY'S LADD close up near the rail, moved up along the inside approaching the stretch, took over for the drive, drew clear but faltered late. PROFILING reserved along the inside, angled out once in the stretch and made a good late gain. PALM SPRINGS forwardly placed four wide, lacked a late bid. GOT A QUESTION sprinted clear, set the pace off he inside and weakened in the drive. SMIRK outrun for a half while in the four path, rallied too late. ECTON ACADEMY forwardly placed three wide, tired. HAR BER HIGH unseated his rider while warming up and ran off for three sixteenths of a mile then was outrun.
