PISH POSH sprinted clear, set the pace near the rail, responded willingly in the stretch and held sway late under pressure. RUN FOR SHELTER reserved early, advanced four wide with a quarter mile to go but lodged only a mild bid for the place. MONTEREY BAY within striking distance, made a good four wide middle move, challenged in midstretch but hung. NO IMAGE close up near the rail, moved out and made a run at the winner while outside that one on the second turn but weakened in the drive. CRASHING SANDSTORM close up three wide, drifted out in midstretch and lacked a late bid. HILLY M reserved early, raced five wide midway through the second turn and could not menace. CULPEPER MOON was no factor. LA ROCKETTE was outrun.
