LADY ASPEN was squeezed between rivals at the start, advanced between horses, was bottled up in traffic near the seven-sixteenths pole, was shuffled back, angled in and came again through the second turn, split horses a furlong out and drew away once clear. ABRIANNA settled saving ground, angled out four wide to make a bold bid entering the stretch, loomed large with a furlong to run but was unable to match strides with the winner. LA RUMBA tracked the pace three wide, forged command inside the three-eighths pole, was collared between rivals in the drive, weakened and settled for the minor award. GOTTAHAVEADREAM settled in hand, tucked in to save ground, came three wide and finished with a mild rally. SHEPPARD'S PIE was unhurried into stride, angled in to save ground, got through and made a belated gain. NATIONAL SPARK made a middle move to ranged into contention, drew even toward the inside five-sixteenths out, but faltered entering the stretch and faded. MIRIMICHI BABE broke a step slow, moved up between horses, drifted out six wide leaving the second turn and came up empty entering the stretch. PELICAN CLUB opened clear to set the pace, was collared between horses entering the second turn and gave way readily once headed. BLAGEUSE failed to respond, was eased to the wire but walked off. EDEN STAR was hustled along five wide, drifted out further on the second turn, stopped and was eased to the wire but walked off. AVOLO was through after a half, faded fast, was eased to the wire but walked off.
