### Footnotes

ARGENTINE TALISMAN was close up along the inside, dropped back between rivals on the second turn, angled out and came again entering the stretch, quickened late and was up in the final yards. RED ACE set the pressured pace toward the inside, battled gamely through a prolonged drive but was unable to resist the winner. SCOTUS settled in hand, launched a bold bid circling five wide, loomed the one to beat a furlong out but lacked the needed late response. GOLDEN CAUSEWAY stalked the pace along the inside, got through entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. LAUBURU was unhurried into stride, tucked in to save ground, got through and improved position. SWAGGER JACK made a long drive four wide to be close up, but weakened between horses entering the stretch and faded. FREDRIK THE GREAT was unhurried, came five wide but passed only the tiring ones. STRIDING AHEAD settled between rivals and lacked a response when called upon. LUMBERYARD JACK prompted the pace three wide, but came up empty between horses entering the stretch and dropped out. STRIKE OIL showed little. TRILLIONAIRE was through early.
