RIVER FLOWER went up early to vie for the lead outside of NASHWAN ROSE (GB), inched to challenge nearing the final quarter, took over, briefly was clear in the final furlong, then lasted under pressure. SALTY FARMA tracked the dueling leaders from early on while four wide, loomed prominently outside RIVER FLOWER through the drive and wasn't good enough. PARTY QUEEN hopped at the start to trail, settled inside, came out eight wide entering the lane and was going well at the end. DICK'S CHICK, unhurried early and three or four wide, dropped back last after going a half, continued three or four wide into the stretch and improved position while unable to threaten. FLAGER (ARG) saved ground from early on while racing within easy striking distance, angled four wide for the drive but lacked a closing account. SWEETWATER PROMISE followed the leaders four or five wide, came out six wide for the drive and was empty. NASHWAN ROSE (GB), a bit rank in to the first turn while managing a narrow lead inside of RIVER FLOWER, settled into the backstretch while dueling with that one, showed the way into the stretch and tired.
