GOLDEN LOCKET, never far back and four or five wide, took over approaching the final furlong, then drove clear under steady encouragement. KHAYELITSHA went up to vie for the lead at once while outside of CAT QUATORZE, alternated for the advantage with that one early, managed a slim edge into the lane, lost the lead to the winner and continued on while inside that one as second best. DUTCH GIRL, sluggish to begin and outrun for a half, advanced four wide into the stretch, split foes four wide at the furlong grounds and offered a mild gain. PROMISED leaned in at the start bumping with SOOEY SUNRISE, was outrun for a half, swung out for the drive and improved position. SAINT KRIS came out at the break bumping SOOEY SUNRISE, then failed to rally in an even effort. CAT QUATORZE alternated for the lead from early on while inside of KHAYELITSHA, held on well until nearing the final quarter and weakened. DEEP WOODS followed the leaders in a striking position four or five wide for a half and tired. SOOEY SUNRISE, bumped at the start from both sides, tracked the pace for almost a half and weakened steadily thereafter.
