STAKES Jenny Wiley S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES AND MARES FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to enter and an additional \$1,000 start, with \$200,000 guaranteed, of which \$124,000 to the owner of the winner, \$40,000 to second, \$20,000 to third, \$10,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of Grade I or II stakes on the turf since September 6 allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000 twice at a mile or over on the turf since August 1, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 twice at a mile or over on the turf since July 4, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, April 6, 2005 with 31 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Eight and One Half Furlongs on the main track.

Footnotes

INTERCONTINENTAL (GB), extremely rank when fighting restraint and throwing her head repeatedly around the first turn, settled just before going a half, swept to the front three or four wide, edged clear, then maintained her advantage in the drive under strong handling. DELTA PRINCESS drifted out when breaking and bobbed slightly, settled three or four wide, was between foes while edging closer on the far turn, came out five or six wide for the stretch run and finished well to earn the place. SISTER SWANK contested the pace at once while racing outside of SISTER STAR, raced under rating while gaining the lead between calls early on the backstretch, lost the edge to the winner soon after, continued in closest attendance to INTERCONTINENTAL (GB) into the final furlong and weakened. RIVER BELLE (GB), nicely placed near the inside from early on, eased around a tiring SISTER STAR concluding the backstretch, loomed inside the winner when straightened into the lane but came up empty. KATDOGAWN (GB), sluggish to begin and maneuvered near the inside, eased out on the backstretch to race four or five wide, was within easy striking distance into the lane and flattened out. SISTER STAR contested the pace along the inside into the backstretch, continued forwardly to the far turn and tired. HIGH COURT (BRZ) wasn't a factor and raced eight wide into the stretch.
