DREAM OF KAYLEE tracked the dueling leaders along the inside, angled out and launched her bid four wide, assumed command inside the furlong marker and steadily edged clear. COGNITO dueled for the lead along the inside, battled through a prolonged drive but was unable to match strides with the winner but held gamely for the place. MORE THAN WILLING settled in hand, split horses to make a late rally and was making up ground well. PHOSPHORESCENT stalked the pace three deep, angled out five wide and improved his position late. DYNAMITE BOB made a middle move five wide, poked his head in front with a quarter to run, but faltered in the final furlong and faded. WAR LAP was rank to place along the inside, angled out entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. PETCH dueled for the lead two wide to the stretch and tired. RADAR MAN broke slowly and trailed throughout.
