**Footnotes**

HENNY'S HURRICANE within striking distance early inside, angled out on the backstretch, moved up three wide on the second turn, drew clear with a furlong to go and held sway late. BLACK TULIP reserved early, saved ground on the second turn when rallying, waited approaching the stretch, got through along the inside with a furlong to go and was gaining late. THE REAL MAYO outrun early, advanced inside on the second turn, came out four wide entering the stretch but lacked a late bid. NORMA'S DREAM sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace to the stretch, held on well to the final furlong and tired. SHES GONE ROGUE close up three wide, tired in the drive. DEPUTY GONE WILD forwardly placed off the inside, saved ground into the second turn and gave way in the drive. BELOVEDA within reach off the inside, stopped.
