Footnotes

JEANBAPTISTE COROT settled saving ground, advanced through the second turn, split horses and angled out entering the stretch, quickened once clear and caught SCUFF in the final strides. SCUFF stalked the pace two wide, forged command inside the five-sixteenths pole, shook clear entering the stretch, kept on well but was unable to resist the winner. SIMMSTOWN contended off of the inside, continued on fairly well between rivals through a long drive and was all out to earn the show. STUNNING SPLIT was allowed to settle, came five wide and improved position. IMHOTEP rushed to contention five wide, was forwardly placed to the final furlong and faded. CONWAY opened clear to set the pace, was collared on the second turn, and gave way readily once headed. GRIND was allowed to settle five wide and lacked a response. TAPANNA broke slow, settled saving ground but was never a factor. SHUT EYE showed little. DON'T GET CAUGHT broke slowly and was outrun.
