Footnotes

CHARISMATIC, within striking distance early off the inside, moved out and made a three wide run into the second turn, challenged entering the stretch and drew clear in the final furlong under steady urging. YANKEE VICTOR pressed the pace off the inside, challenged before a half, gained a short lead approaching the stretch, responded willingly when challenged by the winner, held gamely to deep stretch and weakened. FINDER'S GOLD, reserved early three wide, advanced four wide leaving the second turn, was brushed by EPIC HONOR in upper stretch then hung late. EPIC HONOR, reserved off the inside, made a good middle move to a forward position, was angled out and brushed FINDER'S GOLD in upper stretch then tired. SUCCESSFUL APPEAL drifted four wide into the first turn, was unhurried early, made a mild middle move but had no late bid. ZANETTI, outrun early off the inside, improved his position while no threat. GRITS'N HARD TOAST, fanned five wide entering the first turn, was outrun early, raced four wide into the second turn and was no menace. WALK THAT WALK, forwardly placed three wide, raced three wide on the second turn and faded. LUCKY ROBERTO, close up off the inside, raced four wide into the second turn and tired. TEXAS GLITTER lost his footing at the start, set the pace inside, stayed well to the quarter mile marker and faded. THROWTHEBOOKATEM ridden early to get position, raced within striking distance three wide but was through after a half. SHAKE ME WAKE ME, fanned six wide into the first turn, was outrun.
