Footnotes

TALKMEISTER, never far back while following the leaders under light rating five wide, continued in that position on the course while advancing into the stretch, reached the front at the furlong grounds, then was hard ridden the remainder. STRIKE SMARTLY settled in behind horses early, moved four wide on the backstretch, came out to follow the winner five or six wide on the second turn, put SERAZZO in a bit tight quarters about the furlong pole and finished with good energy. GULF STORM gained a slim lead near the inside early, dueled with JUST LIKE JIMMY, lost the edge to the winner at the furlong grounds and held on stubbornly the remainder. JUST LIKE JIMMY went up early to vie for the lead outside of GULF STORM, battled on about even terms into the final furlong and lacked a late response. CHEROKEEINTHEHILLS settled behind rivals early, raced within easy striking distance, raced four wide on the far turn, was put to a drive three furlongs out, remained prominent into the final furlong and lacked the needed response. SERAZZO, unhurried early, edged closer approaching the stretch while in behind foes, was steadied nearing the eighth pole when STRIKE SMARTLY leaned in, then lacked a further account. FLAMIN' JOLIE followed the leaders in a striking position four wide, was put to a drive nearing the final quarter but flattened out in the drive. TWO POINT TWO MILL angled in behind rivals early while outrun, continued near the inside and failed to rally.
