LESLIE gained the lead at the start, moved near the inside, drew off into the backstretch, controlled the balance of the pace and was going under solid hand urging in the late stages. DIXIE VELVET, within striking distance while following the winner four wide most of the way, earned second but couldn't threaten. CHADERA, unhurried for six furlongs, saved ground, improved position along the inside but couldn't challenge. LADY FROM SHANGHAI, well placed in behind LESLIE from early on, moved three wide on the far turn, remained in closest attendance to the winner into the stretch and flattened out. CULLBERG BALLET (IRE), unhurried early made a mild move on the far turn but failed to continue. SUNSET SKIES faded after six furlongs. LITTLE LIL, outrun until the stretch, passed tired rivals near the inside. NAROPA was outrun. COUNTESSA broke in the air and was finished early. I'M NOTA ANGEL gave way leaving the backstretch and was eased in the stretch when hopelessly beaten.
