Footnotes

INTERCONTINENTAL (GB) settled early, was taken out seven or eight wide on the backstretch to race widest, edged in a bit around the far turn, was five wide in the drive and was ridden hard to prevail. OCEAN DRIVE, always well placed while following the leaders under light rating four wide, moved with the winner while inside that one entering the upper stretch, battled on even terms leaving the eighth pole but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. MADEIRA MIST (IRE) drifted out at the start, gained a decent position between foes three or four wide, continued in that position on the course entering the lane and finished determinedly for her position. VANGUARDIA (ARG), in front briefly after the start, was eased back outside of CONEY KITTY (IRE), pressed that one four wide, took over on the far turn, made the pace into the final furlong and weakened. CONEY KITTY (IRE) lunged in the air at the start, settled four wide, was outrun for six furlongs, raced into contention six side on the far turn, was eight wide when straightened for the drive and failed to gain in the final furlong. FILM MAKER, within easy striking distance while racing near the inside between foes to the stretch, eased out five wide and lacked a rally. VESPER, unhurried early while saving ground in hand, continued near the rail into the stretch, eased out three or four wide, was steadied between rivals leaving the three-sixteenths pole and never menaced thereafter. VIRGIN VOYAGE moved to the front early, edged near the inside, made the pace for nearly six furlongs and tired.
