**Footnotes**

DEFER, rated off the dueling leaders early and three or four wide, took over approaching the final furlong, responded to strong handling and held sway. SALINJA, never far back and racing under rating near the inside, split foes three wide in the upper stretch, had aim at the winner while inside that one and wasn't good enough. MYSTIC RULER, five or six wide, lost a bit of position leaving the second turn, continued between rivals in the late going and finished well. OUTPERFORMANCE, outrun three wide to the far turn, came out eight wide entering the stretch and was gaining late. KINGSHIP, within easy striking distance four or five wide, loomed prominently for the last eighth and failed to fire. DESERT WHEAT, outrun to the lane, swung out nine wide when straightened for the drive and managed a minor gain. KARELIAN had no rally. DUBAI GOLD, within striking distance and saving ground for six furlongs, eased out five wide for the drive and was empty. WATER GAP, bumped at the start by WILCOX RIDGE, angled in soon after to press the pace outside that rival, gained a slight lead just before going a half, held on well until the final furlong and weakened. WILCOX RIDGE came out at the break bumping WATER GAP, moved to the fore soon after, raced near the inside, lost the advantage to WATER GAP on the backstretch, continued up close into the final furlong and couldn't continue.
