SIPHON THE KITTY behind the leaders, saved ground on the turn, responded willingly in the stretch, challenged with a sixteenth to go and proved narrowly best. GREGORY'S TRICK alternated for the lead from the start, saved ground on the turn, angled out for the drive and held on gamely but missed. SINISTER reserved early, commenced his rally off the inside on the turn, angled out approaching the stretch and closed well on the outside. CAMPSIS behind the leaders three wide, challenged between horses late on the turn, gained a short lead with a furlong to go but faltered late. WON HAPPY BACHELOR within striking distance, made a bold four wide move on the turn, challenged before a half but weakened under pressure. BUCKY CAME HOME vied for the lead off the inside and also weakened. ALL TIZ stumbled after the start, recovered to be close up while off the rail, held on well to the stretch and gave way.
