CARRIAGE TRAIL vied for the lead off the inside, drew clear when ready after six furlongs and maintained a clear lead while kept to the task. SAY YOU WILL (IRE) taken back a bit to race in hand while close up, angled out for the drive but lodged only a mild bid to be up for the place. INDESCRIBABLE within striking distance three wide, made a run at the leaders from the outside on the second turn but lacked a finishing response. MERIBEL reserved three wide, angled out and made a good four wide move on the second turn but had little left late. MARQUEE DELIVERY forced the pace along the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. I'M IN LOVE was outrun while off the inside. PANTY RAID pressed the pace three wide, held on well to the final quarter and gave way.
