Footnotes

NORTHERN BELLE close up inside, angled out stretch, drew clear, kept to task. KEERTANA reserved early, advanced near the rail late on the turn, angled out for the drive and finished willingly to be second best. MARASCHINO RED sprinted early, commenced her rally four wide with three furlongs to go, angled out for the drive and improved her position late. OCEAN COLORS close up three wide, tired in the drive. TERRIFFANY sprinted clear, set the pace off the inside and tired in the final furlong. PAST TWILIGHT within striking distance, raced four wide midway through the turn and lacked a rally. FUTURE STORY angled in early, saved ground late on the turn and could not threaten. WESTLINE angled in when outrun early, saved ground with three furlongs to go and was no factor. WOOD VIOLET five wide into the turn, could not menace. ROYAL CARD three wide midway through the turn, faded. CONNIE MAC (IRE) closer up in the three path, stopped.
