ADVICE in hand for a half, was patiently handled three wide approaching the stretch, swung out for a clear path in upper stretch, bumped the runner up then closed fast to be up in time. CONSERVATIVE reserved early off the inside, angled out on the second turn when commencing his bid, came seven wide into the stretch, was bumped by the winner after straightening for the drive and finished willingly to be up for the place. SQUARE EDDIE in hand early five wide, made a bold six wide move after five furlongs when asked, took over entering the stretch, drifted in with a furlong to go placing MASALA in a bit tight then faltered late. MASALA closest to the pace while reserved, was in tight in midstretch when SQUARE EDDIE drifted in then after being angled out for a clear path, held on well. PITCHED PERFECTLY sprinted clear, set a comfortable pace while off the inside, stayed on well to the final furlong and weakened late. JERANIMO reserved along the inside, moved to contention along the inside on the second turn, followed the leaders into the stretch, lacked a clear path in midstretch then couldn't gain sufficiently when clear late. BRAVE VICTORY within striking distance between rivals, maintained good position for six furlongs, was carried eight wide entering the stretch and tired. PARADE CLOWN forwardly placed early five wide, stayed close up for six furlongs, was in tight when SQUARE EDDIE rallied past late on the second turn then tired. OMNISCIENT close up along the inside, held on well to the final furlong and tired. EL CRESPO within striking distance early four wide, maintained good position to the stretch and tired. HIS GREATNESS forwardly placed, raced in traffic late on the first turn, held well for a half and stopped.
