DUBIOUS MISS vied for the lead while near the rail and unhurried, drew clear when ready in upper stretch, increased his advantage when asked to pick up his pace in midstretch and was gathered up late. KISS THE KID forwardly placed off the inside, moved to be the rail on the second turn while remaining prominent then finished with good determination while not able to seriously menace the winner. GIANT OAK outrun for a half, made a good five wide middle move but could not sustain the bid. JUST AS WELL unhurried inside, angled out for the drive but could not threaten. PALLADIO within striking distance four wide, held on well to the stretch and tired. BIG TOP close up along the inside, moved off the rail on the second turn and gave way in the drive. READY SET within striking distance off the rail, faded. TIMBER RESERVE forced the pace outside the winner, stayed on well for six furlongs and faded.
