SOUTHPAW SLAMMER disputed the pace four wide, opened clear leaving the turn, came five wide and widened. GOOD TICKLED broke slow, was unhurried into stride, split horses entering the stretch and finished willingly to earn the place. ELMOR contended between horses, came four wide to make his bid but settled for the minor award. JOHN GORDON chased four wide, but weakened entering the stretch and faded. HE'S SO FINE tucked in to save ground, got through to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. EVAN'S CALLING contested the pace three wide, but faltered in the final furlong and gave way. TIME TO RIDE was allowed to settle and lacked a response when called upon.
