THERE IS NO LIMIT reserved between rivals, angled out for the drive and closed well to be clear. IT'S SATURDAY NITE vied early off the inside, took back a bit into the turn, came again in midstretch, drifted in a bit then held on for the place. A TIME TO LOVE outsprinted early, raced in the three path on the turn, angled out for the drive but lacked a late bid. THE CAT'S ALL THAT close up early, saved ground on the turn, angled out a bit for the drive, was bumped and in tight in midstretch then hung. READY TO UNLEASH within striking distance along the inside, lacked a rally. INGENUE forwardly placed off the inside, had nothing left late. RALLY THE TROOPS sprinted clear, set a fast pace, drifted out in midstretch and bumped THE CAT'S ALL THAT then tired. MAGICAL CAT was outrun. TOTHEENDOFTHEEARTH (IRE) was no threat inside.
