INCOMMUNICADO gained the lead inside at the start, settled into the stretch with a clear advantage while racing in the three path and was kept to her task. RIGHT ON COURSE, outrun for a half and saving ground, angled outside the winner for the drive and earned the place. STARS IN YOUR EYES, within striking distance and saving ground much of the way, loomed prominently for the last eighth but couldn't produce the needed response. TUNE SQUAD, close up inside into the final furlong, weakened in the drive. FIT TO WIN, forwardly placed in behind the leaders, came up empty when the test came. POPPER wasn't a factor and was eight wide in the stretch. MISS NIKNAR stalked the winner for a half and faded. REDOY'S DRIVE was finished early, gave way and wasn't persevered with.
