SEANANSEA gained the lead inside at the start, raced a bit removed the rail on the backstretch, edged in on the turn, settled into the stretch with a clear advantage, was roused sharply three times on the right side with the whip and finished under vigorous hand urging. PRECIOUS FEATHER, well placed in behind the leaders from early on, angled out four or five wide for the drive but could gain only slightly. REFLECTION BAY, within easy striking distance, couldn't menace the top two while improving position. BRICK SALTHOUSE, in closest attendance to the winner while inside into the stretch, weakened when straightened for the drive. SO WHO CARES, outrun for a half, made a mild bid to reach contention in the upper stretch but lacked a further account. RENDEZVOUS RIDGE, steadied in tight soon after the start, recovered to gain a striking position, held on well for a half and tired. SUFFRAGETTE KITTY failed to menace. TECHNICAL KEY was outrun. LUSCIOUS stalked the winner three or four wide for nearly a half and tired. KISS ME NOT was done early. FANCY CHANCE was outrun.
