TAKE CHARGE LADY maneuvered nicely to the inside while gaining the lead early, edged clear into the stretch and increased her advantage late under solid hand urging. PLAYING 'N GOLD, never far back, angled out to make a run five wide into the stretch, was just off the winner for the drive but couldn't muster the needed response as second best. BEE LINE GENIUS followed the winner from early on, moved in behind rivals, angled out four or five wide for the drive and was empty while swerving in and out through the final furlong. CHILLS gained a slim lead early, surrendered it to the winner, continued prominently into the upper stretch but was empty. CATHY'S DREAM, hustled along the inside early, swung out six or seven wide for the stretch run but failed to respond. COBBLESTONE ROAD, in behind rivals, failed to rally. MAID'S FOLLY wasn't a factor and seven or eight wide in the drive. ANGEL'S ADVICE bobbed lightly at the start, gained a forward position, then was checked at the three-eighth pole. ETERNAL LEGACY was outrun. CATENA was never close and 10 wide in the stretch run. THAT'S OUR TRICKY, slow to start, was never close.
