Footnotes

SCRIMSHAW bobbled at the start while breaking outward, was checked lightly approaching the first turn behind TRUST N LUCK when bumped by MINISTERS WILD CAT, settled nicely under a rating hold upon entering the backstretch, went along under patient handling while saving ground, moved smoothly three wide entering the stretch, took over approaching the final furlong, was roused three times with the whip on the left side, then, after the rider switched his stick to the right side, was struck four more times to move well clear. EYE OF THE TIGER, off a bit sluggish and bumped soon after by MINISTERS WILD CAT from the inside then from the outside by MOST FEARED, was checked and eased back toward the inside, raced three wide, moved between rivals approaching the stretch, was outside the winner four wide for the drive but couldn't threaten. DOMESTIC DISPUTE, within striking distance and four or five wide most of the way, moved with SCRIMSHAW while outside that one approaching the stretch but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. TRUST N LUCK brushed the side of the gate at the start, moved up quickly to vie for the lead, gained the inside by the first turn, made the pace to the stretch and weakened. MINISTERS WILD CAT came out bumping EYE OF THE TIGER soon after the start, was bumped by MOST FEARED and steadied when forced in on SCRIMSHAW approaching the first turn, recovered to press front-running TRUST N LUCK, raced close up until approaching the stretch while between rivals and tired. MOST FEARED leaned in soon after the start bumping EYE OF THE TIGER, came in again bumping MINISTERS WILD CAT, forcing that one into SCRIMSHAW approaching the first turn, raced four or five in a striking position for five furlongs and weakened thereafter. OCEAN TERRACE drifted out slightly at the start, raced in contention for a half while six wide, gave way soon after and was eased when hopelessly beaten.
