Footnotes

BANDSTAND contested the pace from early on while three or four wide, battled with SHIELD while outside that one, edged clear into the upper stretch and was kept to her task. SOUTHERN FLU tracked the dueling leaders from early on while four wide, loomed prominently outside BANDSTAND through the drive and wasn't good enough. SHIELD vied for the lead inside early, battled with BANDSTAND to the stretch and couldn't continue. SAND DREAM, outsprinted early, raced near the inside, swung out five wide for the drive and was empty late. BIRDIE SETS SAIL, outrun three wide for five furlongs, improved position slightly but never menaced. TRADITIONALIST, sluggish to start and forced in when bumped by MRS. STEPHENS, weakened upon going a half. MRS. STEPHENS bore in at the start bumping TRADITIONALIST and never was prominent. GINGER LIGHT tracked the leaders for a half while five wide and tired.
