BEHINDATTHEBAR outrun early, advanced in the two path on the second turn, angled out for the drive, drifted in with a furlong to go, angled back out and finished well to be up in time. SAMBA ROOSTER sprinted clear, set a fast pace while off the inside, led the field into deep stretch and failed to last. RILEY TUCKER forwardly placed three wide, closed in on the leaders on the second turn, reached closest to the pace with a furlong to go but hung late. RACECAR RHAPSODY outrun for a half, commenced his rally in the two path with less than three furlongs to go, was in close quarters with a furlong to go, angled out for room and closed fast on the outside. BIG GLEN reserved early, made a good middle move along the inside, but could not sustain the bid. TOMCITO outrun early, saved ground on the second turn and made a good late gain. SALUTE THE SARGE forwardly placed, raced three wide late on the second turn, came wider for the drive, drifted in with a furlong to go and tired. ATONED reserved early, raced four wide into the stretch and could not threaten. ST. JOE closest to the pace off the inside, raced in the three path on the second turn and gave way in the drive. RED SANDY four wide early, was no factor. FELON within striking distance off the inside, stopped.
