Footnotes

RESCUE SQUAD stalked the pace removed from the inside, got through entering the stretch, inherited command when MR ALL AMERICAN bore out and increased his advantage. MR ALL AMERICAN pulled to the fore to dictate terms, bore out leaving the second turn, continued to bear out through the stretch but held the place despite finishing near the outside fence. SAL THE BARBER was allowed to settle, made a late rally circling five wide and was along for the show. MORAL was unhurried into stride, angled out and split horses to make a late gain, and improved position through the lane. SUYETA tracked the pace three deep to the stretch and faded. APPALACHIAN TRAIL was forwardly placed four wide, but faltered from between horses on the second turn and gave way. BACK TO ACK failed to respond. MARILYN'S GUY was reserved off of the pace under a snug hold, advanced from between horses to make a mild bid with a quarter to run but failed to sustain the drive. JUMP START NOW showed little. FLATWOOD HANK contended along the inside through the opening half, then to the outside of MR ALL AMERICAN to the stretch and stopped.
