BONAROO sprinted clear, set the pace along the inside, responded willingly when headed with a furlong to go and edged off late. WILLIAM'S KITTEN closest to the pace off the inside, challenged after six furlongs, gained a short lead with a furlong to go, could not stay with the winner late but held on for the place. DOUBLEFOUR reserved early, saved ground on the second turn, angled out once in the stretch but lodged only a mild late bid. QUICK DELIVERY within striking distance three wide, tired in the drive. KENNESSEY within reach of the leaders in the four path, gave way. ERIC'S KITTEN out sprinted early, raced off the inside and could not threaten. STREAM CAT forwardly placed off the rail, stopped.
