Footnotes

SISTERHOOD tracked the pace four wide, took over entering the stretch, shook clear and widened. MYRIAD was unhurried into stride, commenced her rally four wide with three furlongs to run, angled out further entering the stretch and kept on well to prove second best. NITARA sprinted to the fore and tucked in to set the pressured pace, was unable to match stride with the winner entering the stretch, weakened during the drive but had enough left to preserve the show. CAT LORE attended the pace between horses, came three wide but lacked the needed late response. NECHEZ DAWN prompted the pace three wide, but faltered between horses entering the stretch and faded. IRISH EXCHANGE was forwardly placed four wide to the stretch and retreated. NEVER TELL LYNDA broke slow, was unhurried early, finished with a belated gain but was never a factor. EMONA was allowed to settle five wide, came seven wide and failed to respond. PLUS ONE broke in the air, rushed to contention along the inside, but came up empty after a half and dropped out.
