DANCE DAILY, sluggish and awkward to start after bobbling when the ground appeared to break out from beneath her, was forced in a bit by TOUCH OF SALT when that one leaned in, settled in behind horses, maneuvered out five or six wide when straightened for the drive, then drove clear late in a smart debut. NEVER ENOUGH stalked the pace four wide, was with DANCE DAILY while inside that one in the final furlong but couldn't match strides late as second best. READY TO PLEASE, never far back, ranged up four or five wide for the drive, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth but couldn't muster the needed response. LUNARGAL gained the lead early from the outside, battled with WHATSITGONNATAKE, shook off that one, edged in a bit entering the lane while managing a clear advantage but couldn't last. WHATSITGONNATAKE, close up from the outset, edged inside, then weakened leaving the turn. STAND BY THE PHONE failed to rally and was six or seven wide in the stretch run. TOUCH OF SALT drifted in at the start forcing the winner in a bit, then never menaced. SILVER POKER tired approaching the stretch. MISS MAGOO hopped and swerved out at the start and never was prominent while five or six wide.
