Footnotes

OLYMPIST outrun early, moved in on the backstretch, angled out for a clear path with a furlong to go and closed well late. CAJUN PRIZE within striking distance, moved around FIRST GOLD entering the second turn, saved ground on the second turn, angled out a bit for the drive and finished willingly to miss. SKIP CODE failed to relax when in hand early inside, pulled down the backstretch, steadied entering the second turn in traffic, angled out for the drive, made a good run to take over with a furlong to go but faltered to miss. CUSTERS LAST STAND within reach three wide, moved closer after a half, reached a challenging position in midstretch and finished willingly late. JUMP RIGHT IN forwardly placed off the inside, raced three wide on the second turn and weakened. POINTMAN TALKIN outrun early four wide, never threatened. KING SNAKE forced the pace off the rail, took over before a half, held on well to the stretch and tired. BOONDOCK ROMEO was outrun. FIRST GOLD vied for the early lead inside and stopped.
