INTO THE FRAY vied for the lead off the inside, took over after a half and drew off under steady urging. SPRING WARRIOR forwardly placed off the inside, angled out a bit for the drive but lacked a late bid. HILARIUM forced the pace three wide, stayed on well to the stretch and tired. FOREST JINGLES prominent four wide, dropped back a bit on the turn then gave way in the stretch. ARMAGNAC bumped at the start, raced within reach of the lead three wide, angle out for the drive but lacked a late bid. SMART FARDA reserved early inside, made a mild run to mid stretch but could not sustain the bid. WICKERSHEIM outrun early, angled out four wide into the stretch, was in close quarters in mid stretch then could not threaten. CYTHEREAN bumped at the start, raced five wide on the turn, was carried out a bit in upper stretch then could not menace. FORT BOONESBOROUGH within striking distance in the three path, tired. TONY BLUE EYES bumped at the start, recovered to be prominent four wide but faded. STRONG DEFENCE outrun early, steadied in mid stretch then was galloped out to the finish. VOUCHER alternated for the lead along the inside and faded.
