UNFURLED, near the inside for a half, came out three or four wide to go after front-running ON THE FRITZ, caught that one approaching the final sixteenth and was under urging to edge clear late. ON THE FRITZ moved to the fore inside early, established solid fractions while drawing off on the turn, remained clear into the final furlong but could not last. RE LYD, outrun until the stretch, made a mild run to reach contention a furlong out but lacked a further account. LEGENDARY PEACH, outprinted early, reached contention near the inside on the turn, angled out to follow the winner from the outside into the final furlong but flattened out. DROMARA, outrun until the stretch, failed to threaten while improving position. CLOUDS OF MIST, sluggish to begin, passed tired foes. KICK STAGE raced forwardly four wide for a half and tired. ALICE ROSE, forwardly between rivals early, faded on the turn. MOTOWN MEDLEY was finished early on the turn. CHELSIE broke in the air, rushed up soon after to attend the pace, held on for a half and gave way
