Footnotes

BROAD HOPES, a bit sluggish to begin and taken in hand, raced five wide from the backstretch on, was put to a drive leaving the seven-sixteenths pole, swept to the front five wide in upper stretch, dropped inside when clear and expanded her lead under strong handling. EVIL EYE ALY, bumped at the start by DARBY'S CHARM when that one came out, was never far back, tracked the leaders three or four wide, was inside the winner when straightened into the lane and couldn't match strides as second best. DARBY'S CHARM came out bumping with EVIL EYE ALY at the start, went up soon after to vie for the lead while battling outside of ROYAL LIVERPOOL, took over and opened a clear lead, made the pace to the stretch and weakened. NO LLORES CATITA (CHI) followed the pace four wide, loomed a solid threat entering the stretch and flattened out. ROYAL LIVERPOOL, briefly in front inside early, eased outside of front-running DARBY'S CHARM on the backstretch, remained a forward factor to the lane and tired. NASTY AND CRAFTY, checked along the inside on the first turn and into the backstretch, weakened after five furlongs.
