Footnotes

LEMON CUSTARD broke a full step slow to immediately trail, was unhurried while three wide to the far turn, came out six or seven wide to advance approaching the stretch, then closed relentlessly under pressure to wear down INCLUDE US in the late going. INCLUDE US gained a striking position in behind horses early, eased out three or four wide for the drive, reached the front in deep stretch, then failed to hold the winner safe. SALE PENDING edged in early to track the dueling leaders four or five wide, inched forward nearing the lane, stuck a head in front at the furlong pole but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. THREEDRINKMINIMUM, outrun inside for six furlongs, swung out nine wide for the drive and managed a mild gain. HAWAII CALLS, well placed from the beginning, raced five wide, was put to a drive about the five-sixteenths pole, remained a threat into the last eighth but failed to fire. DIAMOND FEVER, within easy striking distance while between foes three or four wide to the stretch, came up empty. COUNSELLED went up early to vie for the lead three or four wide, battled with WOOD BE ME while outside that one, raced on even terms into the last eighth and faltered. CHRISCODEY weakened approaching the stretch. WACCAMAW DRIVE was outrun. WOOD BE ME battled for the lead along the inside for nearly seven furlongs and tired. WILL HORN, fractious a bit before the start, was done early.
