STAKES Giant's Causeway S. Listed - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start, with \$100,000 added, of which 62% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three year old fillies, 117 lbs.; Older fillies and mares, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 twice on the turf since October 6 allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000 on the turf since October 6, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Giant's Causeway will be limited to twelve with two also eligibles. In the event that more than twelve fillies or mares pass the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners, then highest 2006-2007 turf earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A set of four silver julep cups will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, April 11, 2007 with 30 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Six Furlongs on the main track.

Footnotes

FOREST CODE, full of run early while tracking the pace four wide, put a head in front just prior to going three furlongs while battling outside of HADDIE BE GOOD, lost the advantage back to that rival at the eighth pole, then came again under urging to draw clear. HADDIE BE GOOD attended the early pace while between horses three or four wide, was head and head for the lead inside the winner on the turn, poked her head in front at the furlong grounds, then couldn't sustain the needed momentum while lasting for the place. SOUTH NECKING (ARG), never far back, loomed four or five wide for the last eighth but couldn't muster the needed response. COSTUME DESIGNER outrun to the stretch and three or four wide, angled six or seven wide for the drive and managed a minor gain. CUABA, within striking distance always and five or six wide, flattened out in the late going. TALE OF THE DEVIL, outrun near the inside to the stretch, eased out four or five wide for the drive and improved position. MISS PENNY FORTUNE hit the side of the gate while breaking slowly,

was outrun to the lane, maneuvered six wide for the drive, then failed to gain in the late going. ITUNA attended the early pace inside, fell back on the turn, remained in contention into mid-stretch and was empty. MADAM MANGUY (AUS) weakened after three furlongs. STADORE (FR) was finished leaving the turn. LIVIA B QUICK raced off the inside and never was prominent. SERENA'S CAT sprinted clear briefly during the early going, lost the lead entering the turn, continued forwardly for three furlongs and faded soon after.
