CAJUN PRIZE opened clear to set a dawdling pace, was well rated through the opening three-quarters, shook off the challenge leaving the second turn, kicked away and gamely led throughout. HYRACOTHERIUM settled along the inside, advanced between horses through the second turn, angled out nearing the quarter pole, came five wide and was all out to earn the place between horses. PROMISEI'LLBEHOME broke a step slow and was pinched back at the start, settled along the inside at the tail of the field, swung seven wide to make his bid, but flattened out in the final yards. DR. ALEX was unhurried into stride, responded when roused with three furlongs to run, circled six wide and loomed a danger entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. MOTOWN SHUFFLE attended the pace three deep, angled in on the second turn, slipped between horses entering the stretch to make a bold bid, but weakened during the drive. DON'TWAIT TOOLONG pulled five wide, made a middle move and ranged up to engage the leaders leaving the second turn, but came up empty in the drive and faded. PROVE YOURSELF chased the pace three wide to the stretch, but faltered between rivals dropped out after a mile. GRUENEWALD forwardly placed along the inside for a half and retreated.
