Footnotes

KINGOFTHEBLUEGRASS set the pace along the inside, responded when challenged on the second turn and proved narrowly best. ORDINATION (IRE) closest to the pace off the inside, challenged the winner on the second turn, battled to the end but was outfinished. CODEWORD (IRE) reserved early off the inside, steadied behind rivals approaching the second turn, angled out for the drive but lacked a late bid. IT'S ABOUT IMAGE within striking distance off the rail, angled out a bit approaching the stretch but had nothing left. SIX PACK ABS forwardly placed from the start, saved ground on the second turn and tired. STREAM CAT outrun early, raced four wide out of the second turn and could not menace. GREAT RISK three wide early, was no factor. RIVERS LEGACY forwardly placed in the three path, held on well to the stretch and gave way.
