SCREENPLAY sprinted clear, set the early pace while out in the four path, moved in a bit while negotiating the second turn, responded willingly in the stretch and held sway late. NAJJAAR within striking distance three wide, moved in a bit on the second turn then finished willingly late. RED STRIKE close up three wide, moved in to the two path on the second turn while tracking the leader, angled out into SATURDAY LAUNCH in upper stretch then lacked a late bid. SATURDAY LAUNCH close up five wide, moved to the four path on the second turn, was bumped and carried out by RED STRIKE in upper stretch then weakened. POSITIVE SIDE forwardly placed four wide, lacked a rally. HUMBLE AND HUNGRY pulled early when close up and three wide, moved to the rail on the second turn and tired. ANY GIVEN ROYAL within reach four wide, tired.
