Footnotes

MORE ACTION, well placed inside from early on, rallied from the rail and was all out to wear down SWEET MELODY in the late going. SWEET MELODY bobbed at the break when the ground appeared to break from beneath her, recovered to gain a slim lead inside while dueling with GOOD GOSH BETTY, shook off that one, then failed to hold the winner safe. GOOD GOSH BETTY went up early to contest the pace outside of SWEET MELODY, held on well until the upper stretch but couldn't sustain the needed momentum while dead heating with HONEYMOON SECRETS for third. HONEYMOON SECRETS, five or six wide while in a striking position most of the way, failed to offer a serious late bid and finished evenly with GOOD GOSH BETTY. MARIAH'S CAT settled four wide, worked her way out seven wide for the drive and lacked a late account. SUMMER CIELO, well placed between foes three or four wide into the stretch, flattened out in the drive. KING'S ANSWER drifted out at the start, was used early to gain a position four wide to track the leaders and tired in the drive. LADY COZZETTE never was prominent. CARE TAKER was outrun.
