Footnotes

KEYS, unhurried early, advanced four or five wide on the far turn, angled six wide into the lane, then closed determinedly under pressure to be along in time. SIXTY ROCKETTS, unhurried early and near the inside, edged closer on the far turn, continued inside to take over entering the upper stretch, then failed to contain the winner's surge. WINLOCS GLORY DAYS, well placed in hand from early on, raced between foes three or four wide, moved a bit wider to make a serious run into the final furlong but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. QUICK QUEEN, within easy striking distance while racing between foes three or four wide, kicked to the front on the far turn, showed the way into the stretch and faltered. SILVER PLATA, never far back while following the leaders five wide, flattened out upon entering the stretch. KIRI'S BEAUTY, away in good order, settled three wide, was outrun to the stretch, came out seven wide and improved position. PUGNACIOUS MILLIE, off slow and shut off, wasn't a factor. MISGOLDY went up to contest the pace four wide, raced up close for nearly six furlongs and tired. CLEVER FANCY swerved out at the start and was steadied, moved to a slight lead soon after while three wide, battled with MISGOLDY while inside that one, was taken up sharply when racing along the inside leaving the five-sixteenths pole when in close quarters, and was finished thereafter.
