ALCOMATCH reserved off the rail, was pocketed along the inside, once in the second turn, angled out four wide entering the stretch for a clear path, made a quick move to challenged and drew clear under steady urging. ODDS ON (BRZ) close up three wide, challenged entering the second turn, battled into the final furlong and held on gamely. ALFARABI never far back while off the inside, bumped with MINE TRAIN in upper stretch when behind a rival then lacked a late bid. MINE TRAIN within striking distance three wide, moved up four wide on the second turn but, bumped with ALFARABI in upper stretch then lacked a late bid. ARIDUS within striking distance along the inside, lacked a rally. WILLIAM'S KITTEN forced the pace off the inside while in hand, stayed with the pace to the final furlong and weakened. VALERIUS outrun for a half, came five wide into the stretch and could not threaten. GUARDED ENTRANCE set the pace along the inside, held on well to the final furlong and tired.
