GOOD BETTER BEST close up three wide, challenged on the second turn and proved best while fully extended. KING TING (IRE) forwardly placed along the inside, tracked the leaders into the final furlong, angled out with a sixteenth to go and rallied willingly to miss and dead head BEACHCOMBING. BEACHCOMBING set the early pace inside, responded willingly when challenged on the second turn, raced near the rail into the stretch and while just off the inner rail the remainder, held on gamely to finish on even terms with KING TING (IRE). SEAL COVE reserved three wide, moved in a bit on the second turn, angled out for a clear path in the stretch and rallied willingly. MAGNET COVE unhurried three wide, angled out a bit for the drive but lodged only a mild late bid. SORGHO forwardly placed off the inside, challenged on the second turn and held on gamely. FORT LARNED within striking distance inside, moved off the rail on the second turn and lacked the needed closing bid. R FAST CAT steadied on the first turn when too eager, moved up four wide late on the second turn but lacked a closing response. FILM MAKING was no threat.
